Child Safety Matters

These state-mandated lessons will be given via videos created by a VCSC Guidance Counselor.

Why does your child need a safety program?

- 10% of children are abused before their 18th birthday
- 14% of children have been solicited online
- 28% of students have been bullied
- 90% of children between 8 and 16 years have viewed explicit material online

The Program teaches about these dangers by:

- using child-friendly language.
- playing fun games and activities.
- providing take-home items to remind children of the lessons.
