Backpacks & Belongings

- Please keep toys, electronics, and other personal items at home.

Money & Forms

• Place all money, forms, notes in the blue folder rather than loose in the backpack.

Nap & Bedding

• Send a clean blanket and pillowcase on Mondays.

Communication

• Check the blue folder daily, read newsletters and ParentSquare updates, and notify me of changes that may affect your child at school.

Arrival & Breakfast

- Doors open 7:45 and our day begins 8:00. Arriving on time allows your child to participate in our arrival routines and transition smoothly.
- Breakfast is at 8:15 please have your child eat during that time <u>or</u> before school(no open food from home).
