### **Poisons & Antidotes**

#### **---Lead---**

**Symptoms:** Sweetish metallic taste in mouth, salivation, burning pain in stomach, vomiting usually of blood-stained matter, abdominal cramps, vertigo, cold sweats, headache, muscular weakness, cramps in the calves of the legs.

**Treatment:** Emetics or lavage with Epsom salts; heat to the surface; caffeine, starch water, milk.
